Please Note

- Competitors are limited to riding no more than two horses/ponies on the day. No horse to compete more than once.
- Horses and ponies competing may only be ridden on the day by the competitor.
- The competition will be run according to Pony Club Eventing Rules 2021 Google Pony Club Eventing rulebook
- **Hats.** All hats must be tagged with the new universal aquamarine tag. Hat standards for 2020 will be enforced.
- **A jockey skull cap with no fixed peak is strongly recommended for all levels and compulsory over 80 cms.**
- **Medical Armbands** are strongly recommended and are compulsory if you have any medical condition.
- **Body Protectors standard BETA 2009 Level 3 (purple label) or above are compulsory for the cross country**
- **Stop watches** will **only** be allowed at 90 level and above. No electronic devices allowed e.g. head cameras
- Sharp spurs are not permitted. Spurs should be blunt or with rotating ball and must point down if curved. Misuse will be reported and penalised.
- **Competitors must provide their own number bibs and print their own numbers**
- *The organisers have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.*
